Procurement Communications

DoIT values the opportunity to engage with vendors to learn about industry trends and evolving technologies. However, please be aware of the following guidelines during our interactions:

Discussion Limitations:

- **DoIT's Scope of Discussion:**
 - We can ask questions about your products and services, past projects with governmental entities or clients, and other relevant details to understand your company better.
 - We cannot share information about our future solicitation plans or anything that might give a competitive advantage to one vendor over another.
- **Reporting Requirements:**
 - Conversations that provide material information, relate to a potential action, and concern an active procurement matter must be reported to the Procurement Policy Board. For more information, visit [Procurement Communications Reporting](#).
 - If you are a lobbyist or a lobbyist is part of your discussion, the lobbyist is also required to report the communication.
- **Transparency and Prohibited Actions:**
 - Reporting a communication ensures transparency and does not automatically disqualify your company from bidding. However, if the communication aids in the preparation of a solicitation, your company could be barred from participating on that solicitation.

Product Information:

- Do not provide customized proposals addressing how you will meet State needs, specifications, or architecture details about your products.

Ethics and Gift Policy:

- Due to the State's Ethics Act restrictions, you and your company cannot offer and we cannot accept anything of value from you or your company.
