
# New In-Meeting Cohost Role

- and more





### **Enhanced Mute Controls in Meetings**



Host and Cohosts can now choose whether participants can unmute themselves when selecting Mute All or Mute on Entry. Additionally, when a host or cohost unmutes a participant, that participant will be given a prompt to unmute, instead of being unmuted directly.


# Video Thumbnail Improvements



Participant interaction options are now condensed into each participant's thumbnail menu.


For users who do not have video turned on or a profile picture set, their name will now be displayed in the video window instead of their initials for a more intuitive experience.

## Grid View Support for Mobile Devices



**Webex Meetings mobile app users** will now be able to experience 5x5 grid view (landscape mode) and 3x7 grid view (portrait mode) on their tablets, including iPads and Chromebooks.

Three new advanced video options to improve camera brightness, reduce camera CPU usage, and select the fastest camera capture framework are now available:


- hardware acceleration for video (Windows only)


